What is the Co-Occurring Disorders and Treatment Conference?

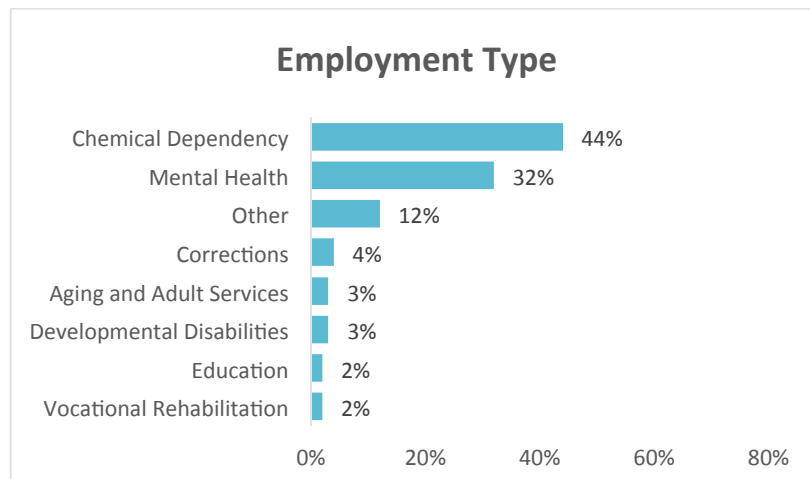
- The Co-Occurring Disorders and Treatment Conference is Washington's largest conference focusing on integrated treatment for co-occurring disorders and recovery.

Advances in Care and Recovery

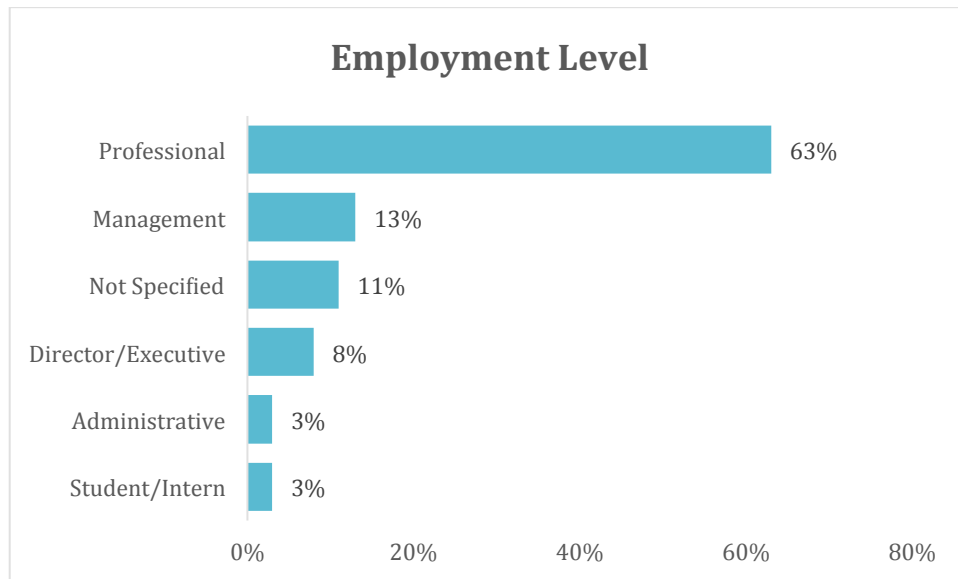
Employment Type
